

2008 QUALIFYING TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

THE DURAMED FUTURES TOUR

November 6 – 9, 2007

ELIGIBILITY

Entries are open to professional and amateur women golfers who were female at birth.

Amateurs must demonstrate that they have an approved and authenticated USGA handicap of five (5.0) or less when submitting application for the Duramed FUTURES Tour Qualifying Tournament. International amateurs must provide written verification from a recognized amateur golf association in their country.

Entries are subject to the eligibility requirements of the Duramed FUTURES Tour Player Policies and Procedures and are subject to rejection at any time (including during the Tournament) by the Duramed FUTURES Tour. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct.

ENTRIES: FORM, FEES, CLOSING DATE

Applicants must submit a Duramed FUTURES Tour application for entry accompanied by the entry fee to the Duramed FUTURES Tour, 1643 Williamsburg Square, Lakeland, FL 33803. Entries open on August 15, 2007. A maximum of 312 entries will be accepted on a first come first serve basis. When 312 entries are received, an alternate list will be started.

The entry fee for 2007 Duramed FUTURES Tour members is \$500.00. The entry fee for non-members is \$700.00. The entry fee must be submitted in U.S. dollars, **made payable to FGTA, LLC. Personal checks will be accepted.** The entry fee will not be refunded to the applicant unless sickness or grave personal injury prevents play. In which case, written notice of withdrawal and request for refund must reach the Duramed FUTURES Tour by the Qualifying registration day, November 5, 2007. A \$100 service fee will be deducted from all refunds.

NOTE: Players gaining LPGA exempt status by virtue of the LPGA Qualifier are eligible for a refund of \$250 from their entry fee.

NOTIFICATION

Notification of acceptance into the Qualifying event will be sent via e-mail to the address listed on the application form. Information will also be available on the Duramed FUTURES Tour web site at www.duramedfuturestour.com. The Duramed FUTURES Tour is not responsible for mail delivery service. It is the applicant's responsibility to contact the Duramed FUTURES Tour headquarters to determine her status. The Duramed FUTURES Tour assumes every qualifier will participate unless the Duramed FUTURES Tour headquarters receives written notice, in advance.

SCHEDULE AND REDUCTION OF FIELD

The competition will be a 72-hole stroke play event. **Any contestant who has scored 87 or higher in any round prior to the cut being made will automatically be eliminated from the Qualifying Tournament and will NOT receive status and will NOT be eligible to become a member of the Tour or play in the 2008 season. Not turning in a scorecard will be treated the same as scoring 87 or higher.** Additional reduction or reductions in the field will be instituted depending on the number of entries received. Notice will be posted at Registration.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE AND TIME

All entrants must register in person at Cleveland Heights G.C. on Monday, November 5, 2007 between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. EST. Players who fail to register will be withdrawn from the Qualifying Tournament. No refund will be made for such withdrawal.

PAIRINGS AND TEE TIMES

First Round Pairings and Tee Times will be available approximately one hour following the close of Registration on Monday, November 5th. Subsequent rounds tee times will be available following play at each tournament golf course and on the web site at www.duramedfuturestour.com

PRACTICE PRIVILEGES

Complimentary range balls will be provided to all contestants (prior to completion of their rounds each day) during the 4 days of the competition. Range balls will be available for purchase following a player's round each day.

NOTE: Players and/or caddies may not play practice rounds or walk any of the tournament courses they have not competed on, once the tournament has begun. Any violation of this policy may result in the player being withdrawn from the tournament. Designated practice areas at each course are open to players.

CADDIES, AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION

All contestants must take a cart. There will be 2 carts assigned per group. All players must take a cart and must ride during the play of a hole as well as from green to tee. Caddies may be employed in addition to the cart. All golf bags must be on the cart. No volunteer cart drivers will be provided or allowed. Caddies must wear flat (no heel) rubber-soled shoes. No spike shoes or spikeless golf shoes of any kind are allowed. Detailed Caddie Regulations will be available at registration.

ACCOMMODATIONS

No private housing will be provided. Information regarding available hotel accommodations will be forwarded to all entrants upon acceptance of entry.

RULES OF GOLF

Play will be governed by the Rules of Golf approved by the USGA and modified by the Duramed FUTURES Local Rules of Play Card and any posted local rules. The Duramed FUTURES Tour Rules Committee, whose decision shall be final, shall settle all questions.

CONDITIONS, SCHEDULES

The Duramed FUTURES Tour reserves the right to alter any of the conditions and schedules herein. The decision of the Duramed FUTURES Tour in any matter shall be final.

PUBLICITY RIGHTS

All television, radio, photo, motion picture and similar media rights for players participating in a Duramed FUTURES Tour tournament shall be granted and assigned to the FGTA, LLC, by virtue of the entry of any such player into any such event. All such rights relating to approved tournaments shall be similarly assigned and granted to the FGTA, LLC. All such rights granted and assigned to the Duramed FUTURES Tour are thereafter the property of and reserved by the FGTA, LLC. Any use thereof without its express and written consent is prohibited.

*If the field does not reach 312 by October 27, 2007 entries will close. At that time the alternate list will also close.
